

Tiny Tiger Graduation Process, Ages 3 to 5

In our Tiny Tiger Program, students ages three to five participate in a wonderful “graduation” ceremony three times a year near the months of February, June and November. This is an excellent opportunity for our youngest students to get comfortable showing off all their wonderful skills. Students are very proud to show their focus and techniques. Parents are encouraged to sit in the classroom for the graduations. Cameras are welcome! The Tiny Tiger graduation fee is \$35 which includes a new belt.

Requirements to Participate:

Karate West does require a certain level of behavior at home, at school and at the dojo before students are allowed to participate in graduations and tests. (We ask parents to communicate with us if there are any issues that would prevent a child from testing or graduating).

- 1) Good home report (child must be behaving at home with respectful and positive attitude).
- 2) Good school report (if applicable).
- 3) New students must have completed one month of training prior to graduation or testing.
- 4) Existing students must not have missed more than one month of training since their last belt exam or graduation ceremony.

Students will be awarded their new belt during the graduation ceremony. Students will be called up individually to receive their promotion and parents are encouraged to join this celebration! If a student does not have enough classes logged to graduate, they may still attend the ceremony. If a student is five years old, they may move up to the Young Achiever Program with instructor recommendation.
